AWGHEM Launched

The ASEAN Working Group on Higher Education Mobility (AWGHEM) 2025 was officially launched at Policy Dialogue 12 on July 27th, 2021.



SHARE builds upon strategic engagement and stakeholder structures through the ASEAN Working Group on Higher Education Mobility (AWGHEM) and the SHARE Higher Education Harmonisation Community of Practice (SHARE CoP).

AWGHEM

SHARE officially launched the ASEAN Working Group on Higher Education Mobility (AWGHEM) at Policy Dialogue 12.

AWGHEM is expected to contribute to the realisation of Outcome 3 of the ASEAN Work Plan on Education 2021-2025, with the ASEAN Secretariat and the ASEAN Foundation as Co-Chairs of the working group and SHARE as the technical and operational advisor with a total of 10 permanent members representing the 10 ASEAN Member States.

Four meetings of the AWGHEM have been held to date.

SHARE CoP

SHARE officially launched SHARE Higher Education Harmonisation Community of Practice (CoP) at Policy Dialogue 13 with a total of 273 members

The CoP is uniting to give voice to higher education practitioners from across the Southeast Asian region towards the harmonisation of the ASEAN Higher Education Space, and to sustain the continuity of SHARE programme results

The capacity of 352 ASEAN stakeholders representing 10 ASEAN countries has been developed through SHARE training and capacity-building workshops.

The Southeast Asian Student and Alumni Network (SEASAN) serves as a platform for ASEAN students and alumni to encourage collaboration and discussion among students and alumni with Higher Education policymakers and practitioners.

The SHARE HE Harmonisation Community of Practice (CoP) was officially launched at Policy Dialogue 13 on November 23rd, 2021.

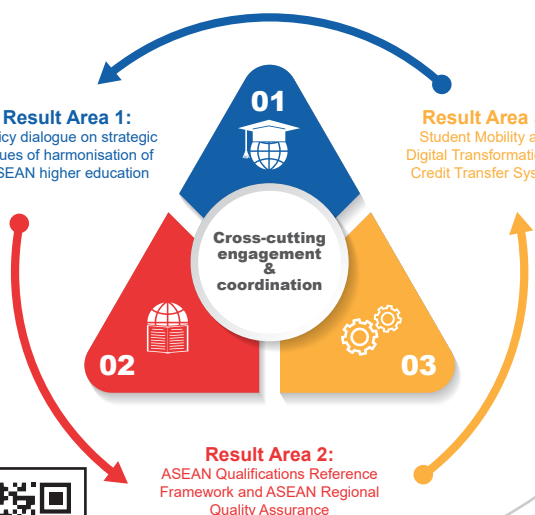
