A Credit System is a standard used by universities to measure and assess a student's work during their university course. A Credit Transfer System is a system agreed on between universities and colleges, in the same country or different countries, to facilitate recognition by, and transfer to, the home university, of a student's learning while at another university. SHARE conceptualised the ASEAN Europe Credit Transfer System (AECTS) as an inclusive process compatible not only with other ASEAN systems, but also with Europe and other Credit Transfer Systems.
